

POLICY ON CONDUCT AND ACADEMIC INTEGRITY FOR STUDENTS

1. PREAMBLE

The Honorable Society of the President and Fellows of the University of Toronto, in recognition of the importance of the highest standards of conduct and academic integrity for all students of the University, and in recognition of the need to ensure that the University's policies and procedures are clear, consistent and fair, hereby resolves:

That the University's policies and procedures on conduct and academic integrity be based on the following principles:

2. JURISDICTION

2.1 This Policy applies to all students of the University.

2.2 This Policy applies to all students of the University, whether they are currently enrolled or have previously been enrolled, and whether they are currently residing in Toronto or elsewhere.

2.3 A student who is found to have violated this Policy may be subject to disciplinary action, including suspension or expulsion, and may be required to complete a course of remedial education.
